West Hills Mall

est Hills Mall, currently the largest mall in West Africa, comprises of 27 458m² and is situated along the Cape Coast Highway, 25km west of Accra, Ghana.

West Hills Mall presents retail of an international standard to Accra. Seamless shopfronts serve Ghanaian, South African and European merchandise along a mall with high quality finishes. Continuous clerestory windows fill the mall volumes with ample daylight to coax the predominantly external retail culture indoors. Restaurants overlooking a square, cinemas, line shops, all anchored by Shoprite and Palace (a local

retailer comparable to Game). African adinkra symbolism is represented abstractedly via 'duafe' (beauty) comb walls, piercing the entrances and a stitching of dark bands of louvres ties the facade together. The overall theme was simplicity over complexity.
